These young people share their parents with others and must learn to adjust to an ever changing home environment. In recognition of their contribution and support to the children who are placed in their home, VOCM CARES and the Newfoundland and Labrador Foster Families Association has established a Bursary Program to assist with educational expenses.

Who can Apply? A biological or adopted child of an approved foster family residing in the province. The applicant must be enrolled in a post-secondary education program.

Bursary Amount: One bursary of 500.00 will be awarded each year.

Application Deadline: Applications and all supporting documentation **must be received** at the Newfoundland and Labrador Foster Families Office by **September 15**.

Selection and Presentation: After reviewing all applications, the selection committee will determine who will be awarded the Bursary. The successful applicant will receive the Bursary in the first week of October in celebration of Foster Families month.
